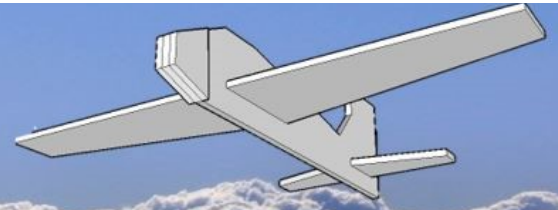

National Primary Schools Glider Challenge

2017-2018 Season 1 for students in Years 4 & 5 (Scotland P5 & P6)

The goal is simple – student teams design, make and fly a glider made from foamboard. The team who's glider flies the furthest on an at-school flight day is invited to a Regional Finals event in the Summer term of 2018. The team that flies the furthest at each Regional Finals is invited to the National Finals to be held on the 27th June 2018 at RAF Museum Cosford. The national 'Fly To The Line' competition winner will be the glider that flies the furthest distance on National Finals Day.

COMPETITION CALENDAR 2017-2018:
