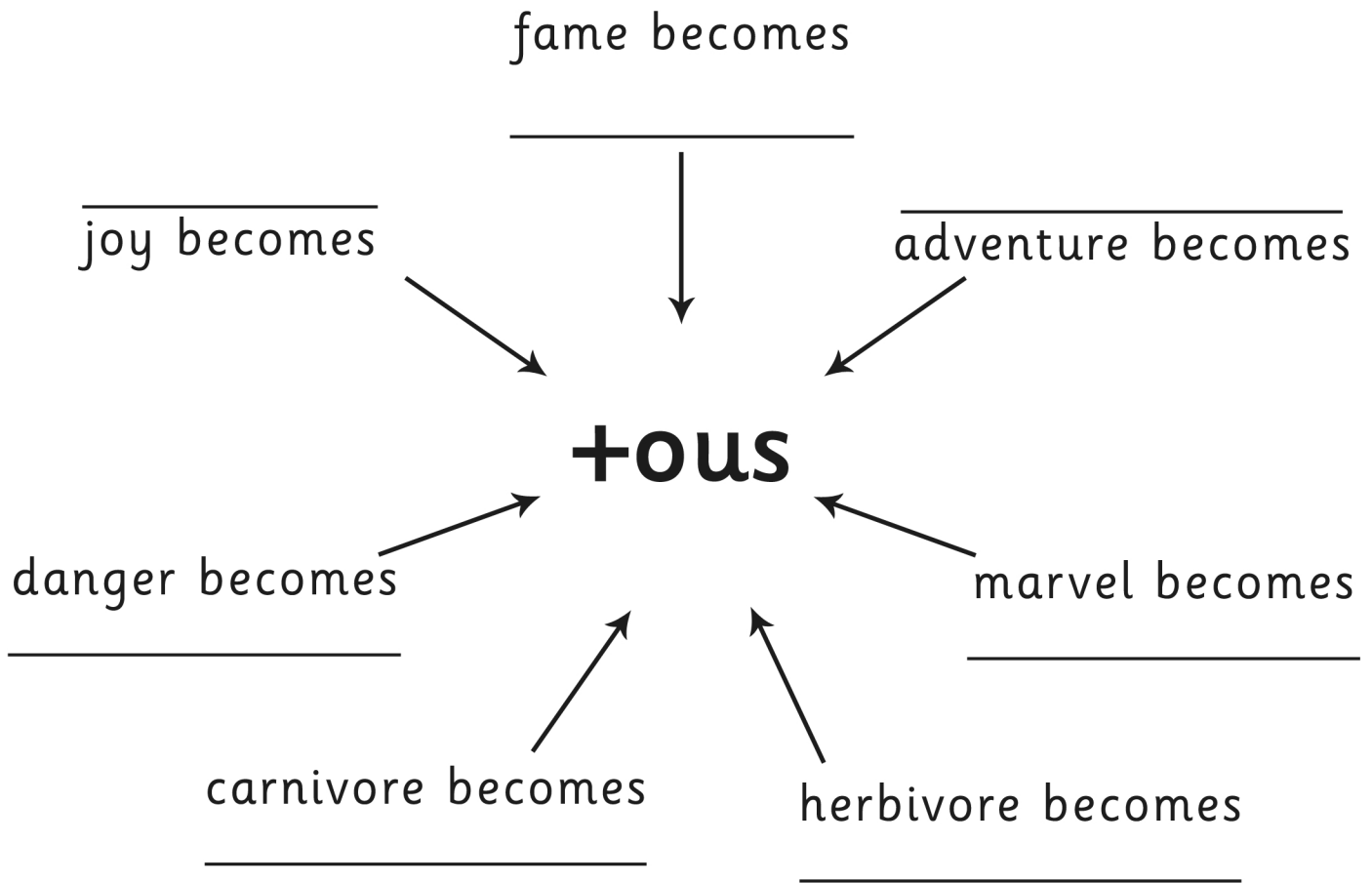

Wordships Spelling Game

Game instructions

A game for 2 players.

Each player needs a laminated game board.

Before the game can begin, each player must secretly choose 10 rectangles in which to write the 10 spelling words or 'wordships'. This week's spellings all end in 'ous' or 'ious' – mountainous, poisonous, thunderous, contagious, curious, dubious, glorious, gracious, hilarious, luxurious.

Players take it in turns to give co-ordinates. Player 1 begins by giving player 2 a co-ordinate, e.g B4. If this co-ordinate finds a 'wordship' on player 2's board, player 2 must say the word and player 1 must spell it correctly. If player 1 spells the word correctly, they sink player 2's 'wordship' (player 2 puts a cross over the word) however if the spelling is incorrect, the 'wordship' doesn't need to be crossed and remains afloat for another turn. The aim of the game is to sink all the opposing player's 'wordships'.

Game Instructions

A game for 2 players.

Player 1 chooses a word from the list, keeping it a secret from player 2. Player 1 counts up the letters and draws the exact number of letter spaces in the game play area below, e.g. _ _ _ _ _ _ (for a six letter word). Player 2 then rolls the dice and the number rolled is the number of letters that player 1 must reveal in the game play area below. Player 2 must fill in the remaining missing letters. Players then swap over, taking turns.
