









Easter Holidays Home Learning Activity Ideas

<p>Play Shannon’s Game: Get a tray with 20 different objects on it. Everyone looks at it for 15 seconds. Then cover it with a cloth and try to write down as many items as you can remember! Winner gets a prize.</p>	<p>Make a scavenger hunt in the garden or on a walk. Collect: a daisy, a snail shell, a fluffy feather, a wing feather, a white stone, a skeleton leaf, a twig in the shape of your initial, a fir cone and 3 bits of rubbish, to put in the bin. Wash your hands when you get in!</p>	<p>Play ‘I went to market and I bought... three lemons. Partner ‘I went to market and I bought three lemons and a red Ferrari.’ Keep taking it in turns to add to the list—you are out if you make a mistake!</p>	<p>Create a Powerpoint on a topic of your choice. Use subheadings for each slide. Make it colourful, eye-catching and informative.</p>
<p>Write a book review of a book you’ve recently read. This could be done as a poster advertising the book.</p> 	<p>Draw and design an Easter egg. What flavour would the chocolate be? What would the packaging look like? Would you include extra treats inside?</p>	<p>Create a treasure hunt for someone in your family to follow. Write clues and think about a prize at the end.</p>	<p>Find a twig in the shape of Stick Man (Julia Donaldson and Axel Scheffler). Watch it on You Tube and make up an adventure.</p> 
<p>Write some Easter/ Spring based Maths word problems. Use a mixture of calculations, including fractions.</p>	<p>Listen to BBC 10 Pieces online with your family: see if you can conduct an orchestra!</p>	<p>Write a letter or make an Easter card to send to your relatives or friends.</p> 	<p>Create an information poster all about you. Include what you’re good at, characteristics, hobbies, likes and dislikes.</p>
<p>Complete 5 acts of kindness. List them down.</p> 	<p>Write a prayer for our school, your family or the world!</p> 	<p>Complete a Science experiment of your choice. Use the Internet or books for ideas.</p> 	<p>Create an exercise program for 10 minutes to share with your family. What exercises will you include? What equipment might you need?</p>
