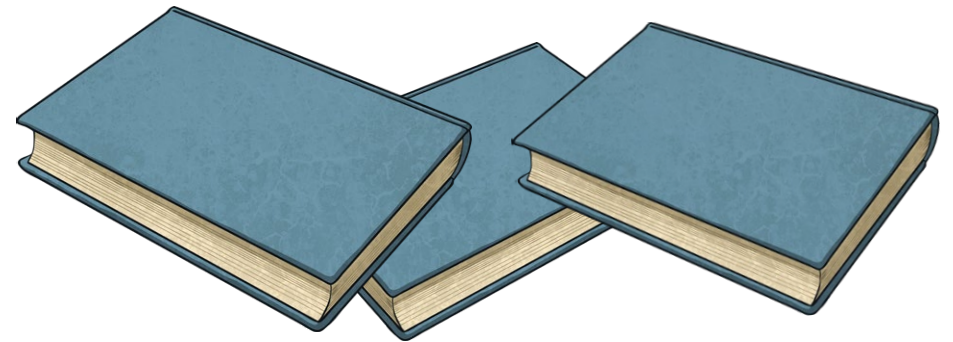

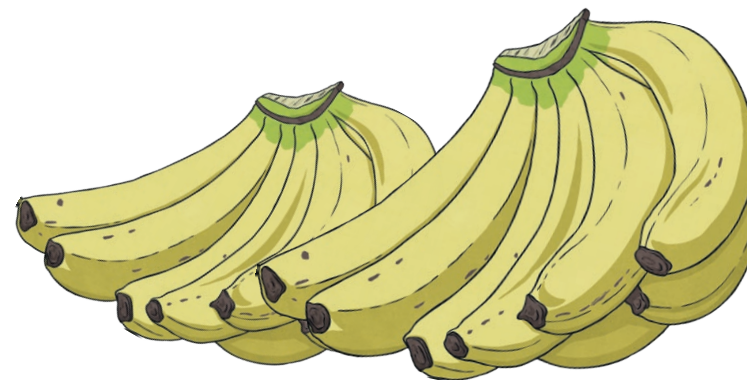
4. A crate of apples weighs 8920g. A crate of potatoes weighs 12.35kg. By how much are the apples lighter than the potatoes?

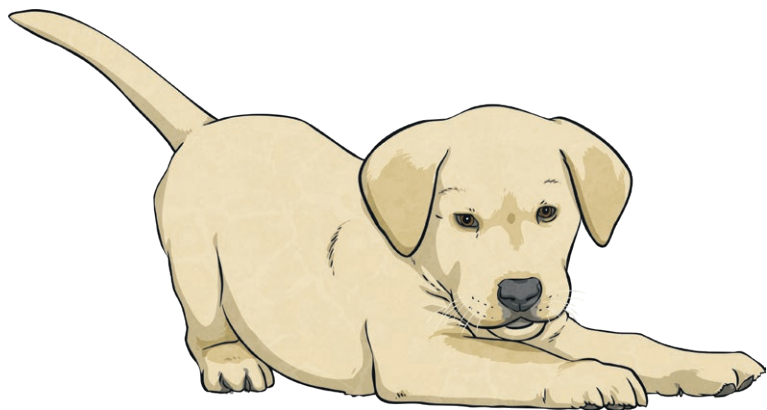
5. 6 bananas weigh 800g. How much will 12 bananas weigh?

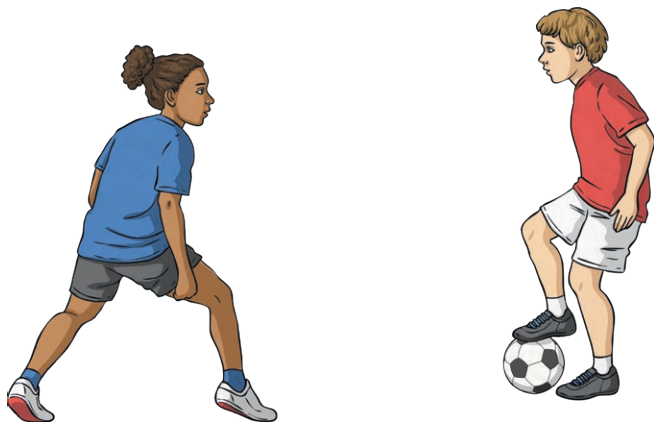

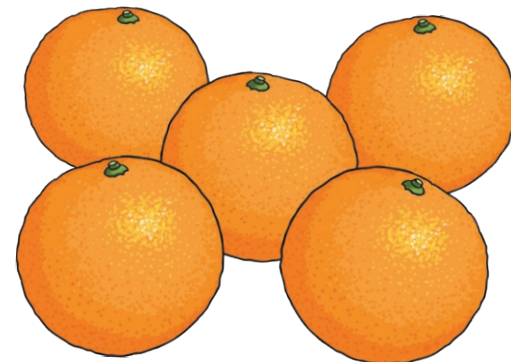

10. Louise was making an apple tart and needed 300g of sugar. She had 1kg of sugar in the beginning. How much sugar was left after she made the tart?



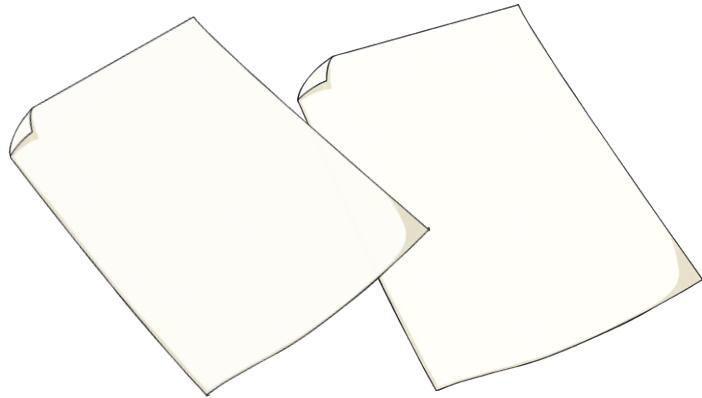

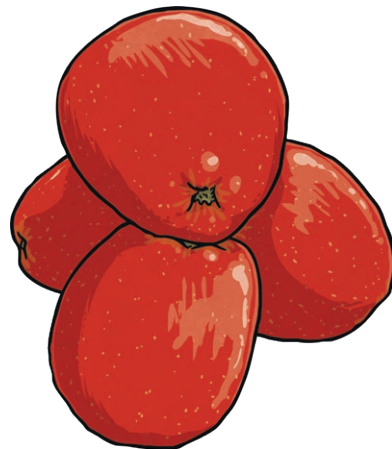

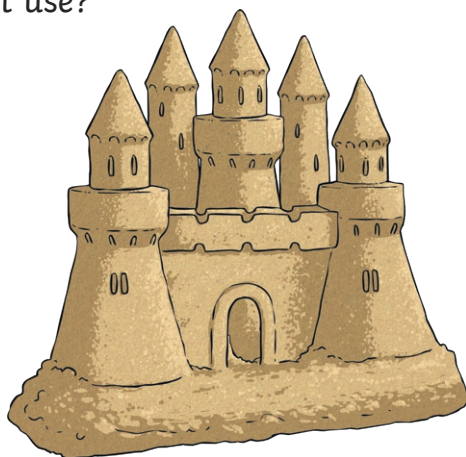
17. A container of strawberries weighed 7.68kg but half of the strawberries were rotten and had to be thrown out. What was the weight of the strawberries that were left?

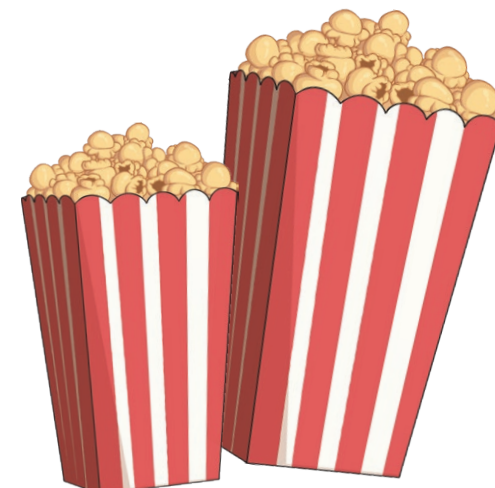
18. Jane was playing with 3kg of sand. She used 400g to make a sandcastle and 1.23kg to make a sand bridge. How much sand did she not use?
